Kenya (3-5 people, help with kids)

Johnny & Ellen Walker

\$2500, December 30/31, 2023 – January 9, 2024

Trip 1: Ellen, a Bible translator, grew up at All Saints (previously OLCC). Her dad was an associate pastor here in the 90s & early 2000s. He then retired and went to Albania for 9+ years. This trip is to a retreat for missionaries from various organizations at a resort in Kenya, January 2-7. The purpose would be serving and refreshing the missionaries with material for the youth, music leaders, and childcare workers.

Trip 2: Are you interested in Bible translation? Would you want to go and see the everyday life of Bible translators Ellen & Johnny Walker and encourage them in their home? Dates would be tailored to those interested.

Guam (large or small team)

The Milners & Guam Vineyard

\$2800, January &/or February 2024

Trip 1: Harrison Thornton is leading a team of young adults to put on a youth conference for our church plant on Guam. The dates are approximately January 12-23/24.

Trip 2: We can send another team in February if more people would like to go. The Milners will tailor the trip to the gifts brought by the team.

Tetovo, Macedonia (5-7 people for intercession & prophetic)

The Mengas & The Shift Center

\$1900, March 15-23

We would spend time at a Christian cultural center in the heart of a Muslim, Albanian city. We'd like to bring a team of intercessors, prophets, and those with a heart for Albania and/or Muslims. The team could also aid in a day camp for kids or youth. We'd also love anyone gifted in the arts to perform for the community at The Shift. For example, Liam Berhard is going to perform opera with Jozef Menga at the piano. These activities foster relationships with the community.

Medellin, Colombia (up to 10 people)

Open Arms Foundation

\$1500, When works for team

This trip would be to a residential home for boys rescued from the streets of Medellin. They would love a team of skilled laborers to help with a remodel. They would also love a team to lead in prophecy, intercession, and biblical teaching. We could take two different teams or a combo in one trip.

Tirana, Albania (young adults & youth)

The Sulas & Disciples of Jesus

\$2200, June 20-30

This is one of, if not the, first church plants in Albania after it opened up following 45 years of communism. The first missionary ASCC ever supported was a YWAM kid named Von Golder who lived in a neighboring country learning Albanian with his wife Sue. They planted this church. Now it is under the leadership of Albanians who came to Christ in that time. They would like a team of young adults to come and do a youth conference for their youth group. Accommodations would be tents on the beach during the conference and hotel rooms on days before and after the event. All team members must pass a background check.

Tirana, Albania (4-6 women)

Eagle's Wings Retreat

\$2200, June

We would be at a residential home for girls at risk of being trafficked. Girls age out of the system in Albania at 14. This organization was founded by four women. Two of the four were sent out of All Saints when it was OLCC. We would put on a retreat for the residents of Eagle's wings for the combined purpose of counseling and a getaway. Space is super limited. All team members must pass a background check. Accommodations would be a hotel or a private home, on or near the coast or in the mountains.
